# Overview

---

- Indiana's TDL industry has benefited from previous Logistics Councils
- Interest was solicited at last year's Logistics Summit
  - Positive feedback & interest
- IEDC, Ports, INDOT, DWD and Conexus Indiana desired to collaborate
- Convened first meeting on Jan, 2007.
  - 53 participants from 41 private industry, academia, government economic development and services organizations
- Discussed major issues & priorities in the industry
